**Re: United Nations Security Council Resolution (UNSCR) 1518 (2003) Pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019 and International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Amendment Act, 2019**

Pursuant to section 43 and 44 of the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019 and section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Amendment Act, 2019 ("IOEAMA") the National Identified Risk Framework Coordinator has requested that the Insurance Commission of The Bahamas ("the Commission") circulate the following Notice regarding Iraq.

Please note that the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolution 1518 (2003), has removed three entries on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities concerning Iraq. The list of the named individual and entities can be found in the press release at either of the links listed below:
