**Re: United Nations Security Council Resolution (UNSCR) 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) Pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019 and International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Amendment Act, 2019**

Pursuant to section 43 and 44 of the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2019 and section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Amendment Act, 2019 (“IOEAMA”) the National Identified Risk Framework Coordinator has requested that the Insurance Commission of The Bahamas (“the Commission”) circulate the following Notice regarding ISIL (Da’esh) and Al-Qaida.

Please note that the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015), has removed three entries on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities concerning ISIL (Da’esh) and A-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings, and entities. Licensees are required to take note of the removal or delisting of the named entities, and any restrictions involving the assets freeze, travel ban, and arms embargo placed on the noted entities shall no longer apply to those listed in the press release.

Companies are also required to notify the Commission, in writing, that the information regarding the removal or delisting of the entities has been noted and that any necessary action has been taken regarding the listed entities.
